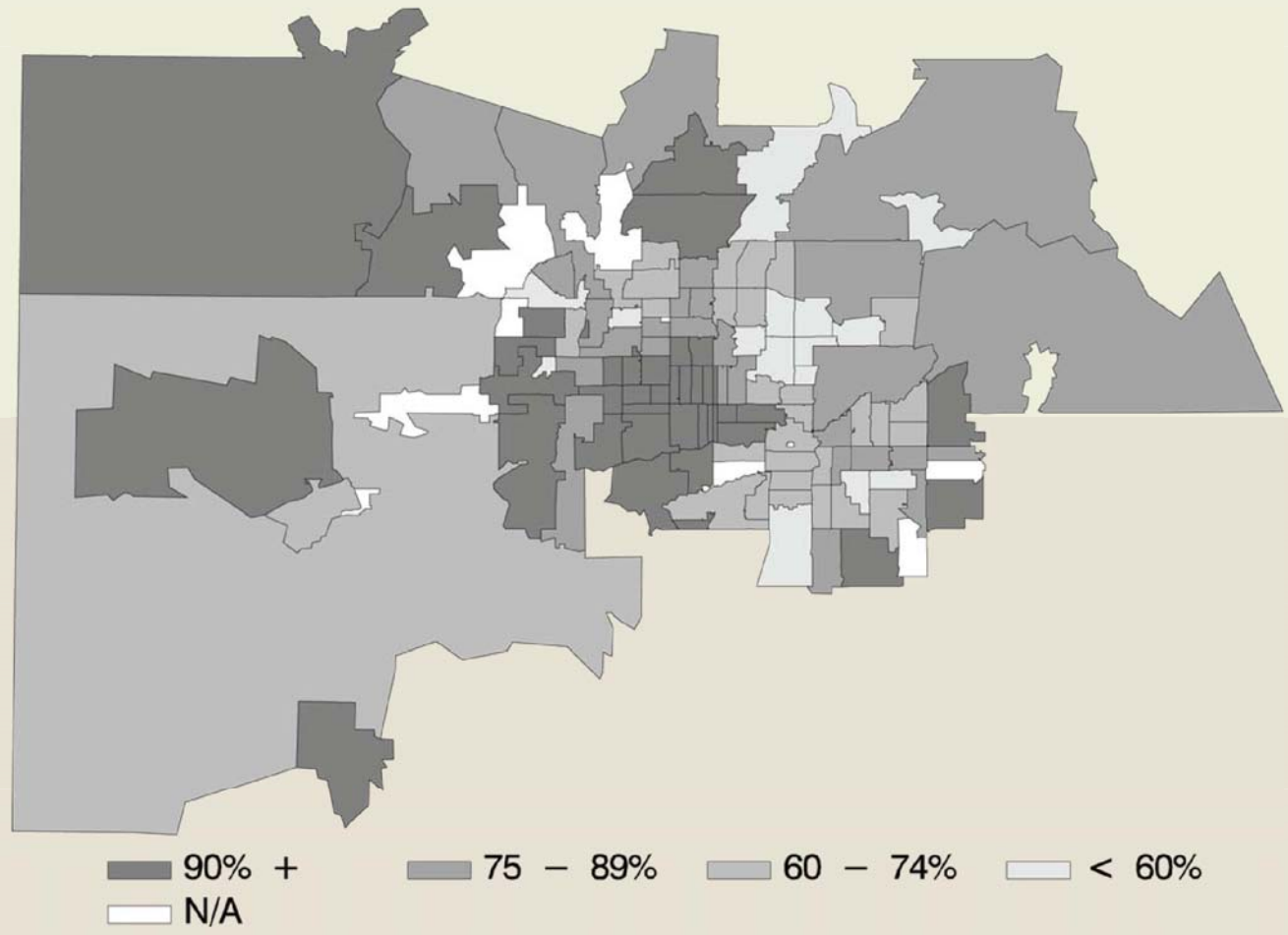

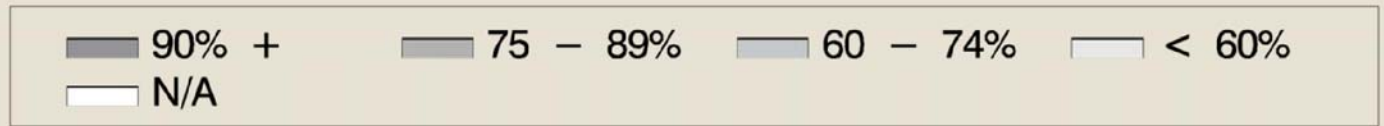
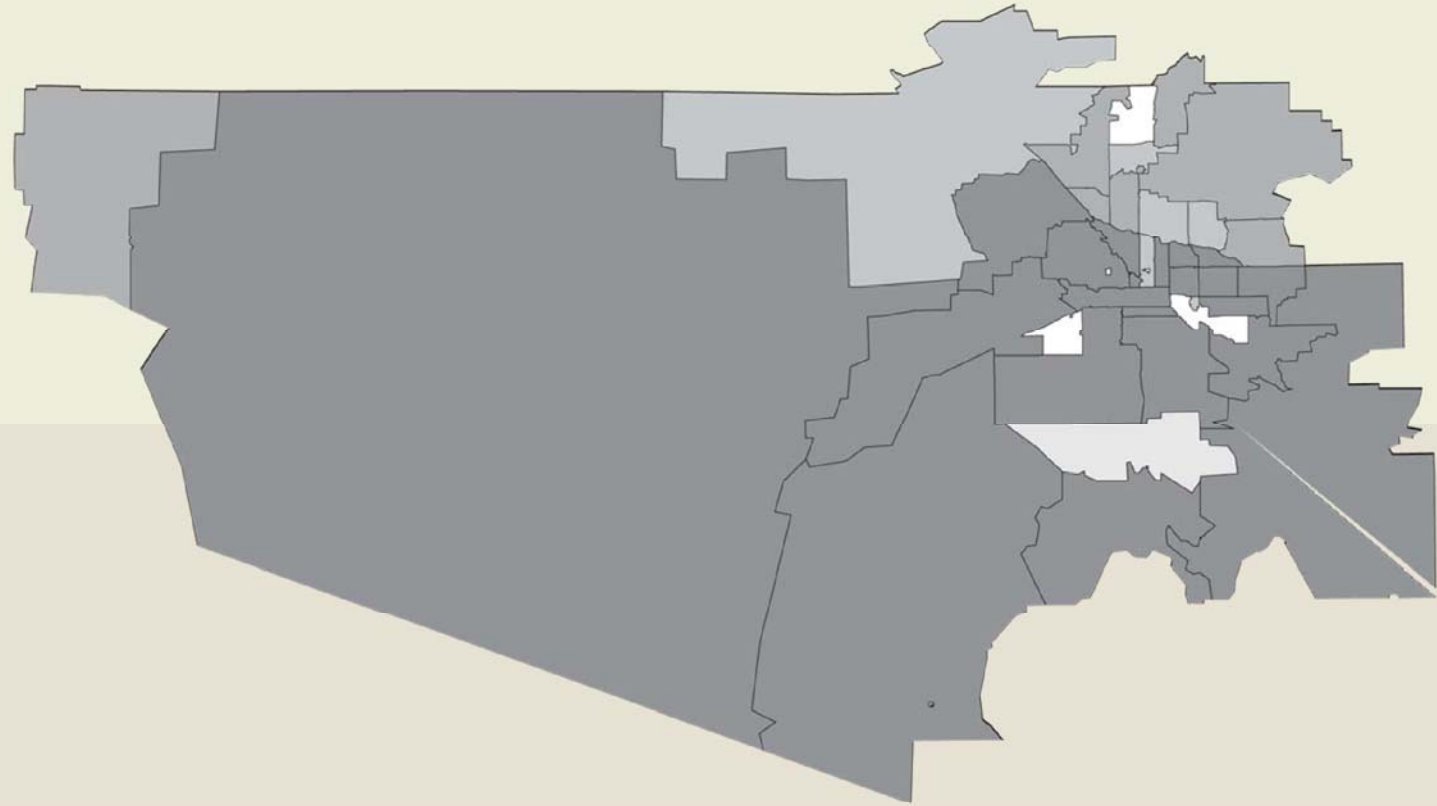


Maricopa County (2004 – 2008): By Race/Ethnicity

Compared to projected 2007 Census



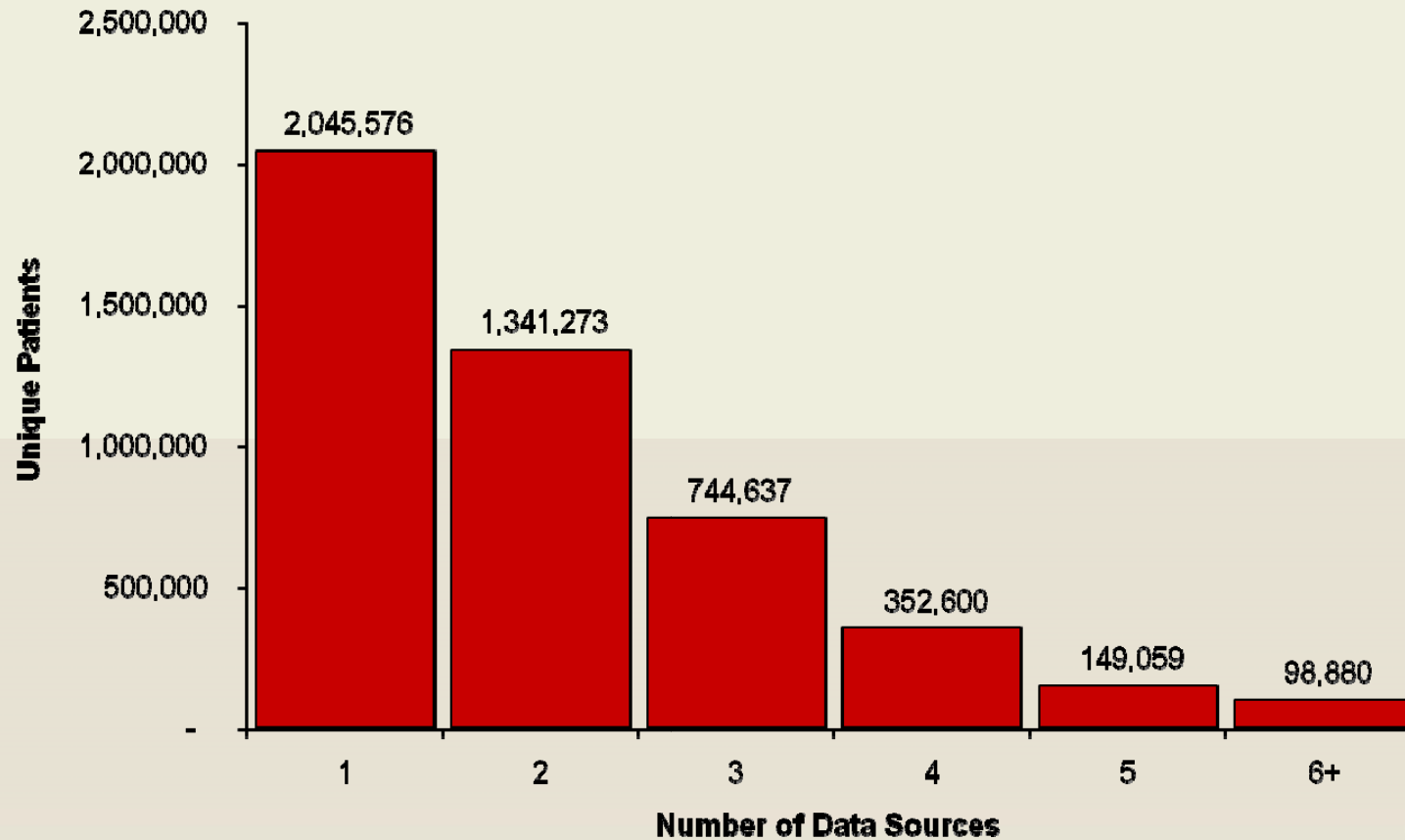

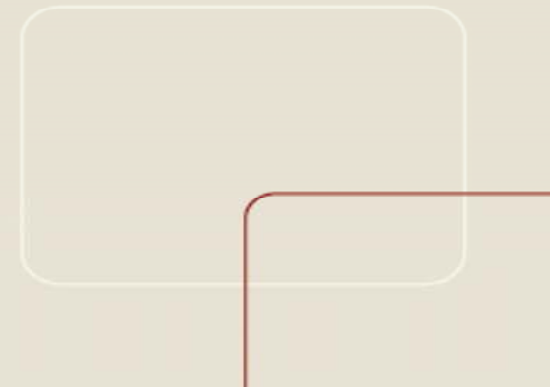


Number of Data Sources a Patient Appears In: 2005 - Present

APCA: Asian Pacific Community in Action

- Cooperative study of health and health care in the Asian and Pacific Islander community with a local coalition. (underway)

Negotiations

New data partners

- United Healthcare (in negotiation)
- SCAN Insurance Program
- Humana (in negotiation)
- CIGNA (final stage for data transfer)
- Magellan (final stage for contract)

Negotiations-2

NOAH project (New Orleans)

- Consortium of health care insurers and providers in New Orleans was referred to us by DHHS as a model for the creation of a community health data system that could serve as a safe haven data repository for Louisiana. (early and outcome uncertain).

Trauma

- Proposed trauma centric database, including the possibility of web-based access for subscribers. We have begun conversations with the Level 1 Trauma Center systems and are evaluating open source software packages for web-based access to aggregate data.

Proposals

NIH study of ethnic disparities in Maricopa County.

- Submitted by CHIR with approval of relevant data partners. Review by end of November.

First Things First

- Proposed effort as a subcontractor to a three university coalition proposing an evaluation of the First Things First initiative for improving the health of children in Arizona. (very recent, complete scope as yet undefined...subject to the approval of data partners)



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
